Gabriele Turck

Born in Bonn, Gabriele Turck started playing the violin at the age of four. She progressed admirably through her education, having studied at the Musikhochschule Köln and Guildhall School of Music in London, where she completed her Bachelor of Music degree with first class honors. Two years later, she was awarded the 'Premier Prize'.

Gabriele has won several prizes in competitions such as the German National Competition 'Jugend Musiziert' and the 'Jakob-Stainer' Violin Competition, a prestigious competition for prodigious young musicians in Germany. She has been sponsored by the 'Jürgen Ponto' Foundation and the Stiftung 'Villa Musica'.

Gabriele frequently performs as a chamber musician and soloist in both Germany and abroad and is currently employed as 'Vorspielerin' of the first violins in the SWR Symphonieorchester Stuttgart.
